We are working in a tribal area in Alirajpur. In our project area covering the 9 villages, small marginal farmers are found having wells and dyke/canals as a major sources for irrigation. Due to scarcity of water they used to find difficulty in irrigation related work from the month of February itself. Watershed activities in this area increased water availability by increasing water level which in turn helped the farmers in proper irrigation during rabi season and also solved the drinking water problem.

WASH in schools (Community development program under ITC Mission Sunehara kal)

VIBHAVARI has been implementing school level WASH programme in Ichhawar and Sehore block of Sehore district with support from ITC Limited since year 2015-16. The project ended in May 2020.

During the project tenure various software work such as Designed & imparted Training for Teachers, Child cabinet, adolescent girls, SMC & MDM members and Swachhta karmi and also organised pratibha samman karyakram, Swachhta Pakhwada, Swachhta hi Sewa Karyakram etc. was conducted. Certain hardware work such as construction of toilets for girls and boys, school boundary wall, MDM wash station, hand wash units, roof water harvesting filter, garbage pits and motor pipeline etc was constructed with the aim to promote positive life skills, participatory and leadership skills through proper maintenance of facilities and a sense of responsibility providing children with an enabling learning environment, which must include the provision of safe water, adequate and appropriate (child-friendly and gender-sensitive) sanitation and hand washing facilities together with hygiene education.

Innovations in WASH

WAHH KIT: WAHH KIT, an innovative activity-based knowledge kit, which is a complete training tool kit for Swachchh Vidhalaya. The activities conducted by this kit disseminate the water and sanitation message effectively.

Soap Bank: SOAP BANK is a new innovation by Vibhavari to ensure availability of soap in schools for hand wash. Child Cabinet has passed a resolution that every student will donate soap to school on his/her birthday. This evokes a proud feeling of contributing something and in turn receiving genuine wishes by other students.

Pad bank: PAD BANK is an innovation by Vibhavari which aims at providing a comfort zone to the adolescent girls. For making a PAD BANK, teenagers (girls from middle school) form a club in

which they contribute for pads and a maintaining a box for the same and refill it as per their requirement. This small initiative gave immense confidence to girls.

Grey Water Reuse: Vibhavari developed a model of hand WASH Unit and attached it with urinal in such a way the grey water which comes through hand washing can be used in urinal directly. This small innovation had benefits in two fold. First, it saved blue water which was used in urinal. Second, it solved the stagnation of grey water as the same quantity is being used in hand wash and in urinal cleaning. Now blue water expense is halved and grey water goes to pit via urinal. In some schools we diverted the grey water to kitchen garden also. This change can be seen as beautiful flowers near the hand wash units or near the hand pumps.

Soil And Moisture Conservation under Mission sunehara kal

VIBHAVARI has been implementing soil and moisture conservation programme in Ichhawar and Sehore block of Sehore district with support from ITC Limited since year 2015-16. The project ended in May 2020.

The project aims for integrated village development through NRM. This program has 4 different segments of operation

- A. Watershed area treatment program
- B. Climate Smart Village
- C. Livelihood promotion program
- D. SHG

Watershed area treatment program

Identify and recharge favourable zones by aquifer mapping and plan for groundwater recharge & focusing on water budgeting, water demand management. Strengthening of existing model of village institution and specific user groups (like Water user groups, FIGs, SHGs, etc).

- ➤ Vibhavari has constructed treatment (Khet khanti) in our field villages with the purpose to reduce soil erosion, increase ground water, field protection & encouraged organic farming.
- Pasture land development in our villages has been done for protection against CCT,
 CPT and plantation in this area
- Stop dam (check dam) is constructed for irrigation purpose and WUG's are formed for operation & maintenance of structure. We developed storage capacity & command area.

Climate Smart Agriculture:

The aim of the program is Dissemination of knowledge on **climate smart agriculture practices** with a focus on small and marginal farmers and encourages farmers for adopting advance farming. The Climate Smart Agriculture program has been implemented of 117 villages. The interventions include soil testing, zero tillage, BBF, Seed Treatment, use of solar trap and other advance practices.

Sustainable Livelihood promotion through Goat rearing model:

This program aims to provide sustainable livelihood for rural community especially landless women. This program includes regular training program as 'Bakari Palak Pathshala' for providing information on advance goat rearing practices including Breed and breeding, Feed & Feeding, Housing & Sanitation, Health management Input Supply, Gaps on market knowledge suggested by TGT so far 2015- to -2019

SHG promotion program

Vibhavari conducted SHG promotion program in 30 villages of sehore district since 2015 focusing on health and nutritional aspect through different interventions (like kitchen garden, nursery development) and gender and financial inclusion trainings planned for the women SHG members.

National Urban Livelihood Mission with Nagar Nigam DEWAS, MP

Vibhavari is working with Nagar Nigam Dewas for National Urban livelihood Mission. The project area covers 10 wards of Dewas Nagar Nigam. This project started from 2017-18 in Dewas. In financial year 2020-21 Vibhavari formed 150 SHG by covering almost every ward of Dewas city and linked them with various livelihood activities as well as linking them with bank.

- FPO bank account: Sonamati FPO has opened its account in Axis Bank, Dewas branch.
- Membership: Current status of members in FPO has increased as 125 new members
 joined Sonamati FPO. The membership fees of Rs. 200 / member is also collected from
 them and deposited in FPO bank account.
- PIMC meeting: The Project Implementation Monitoring Committee will monitor and evaluate the implementation and effectiveness of the project by participating directly in the monitoring and evaluation process and reviewing and providing feedback on monitoring reports.
- Training to Board members and Ceo: Training of 06 Bod & 01 Ceo of Sonamati Fpo done by ISED, Bhopal at Sonkatch.
- Business plan is also prepared for FPO activities.
- We conducted 3 day meeting cum training at 03 villages Gola guthan, Bichkua & Narayanpura of our project area – Satwas during 21-23 March 2021. The purpose of this meeting was door to door Interaction with goat family and deworming camp for goats. Along with it information regarding vaccination, castration, Dana Mishran, Masala Boles etc. was also provided to members.

The project aims on providing sustainable livelihood to (handloom weavers) self help group women who are very poor and now a day due to COVID and drop in family income are suffering a lot. The proposed support from NABARD will directly benefit the women in getting income for their family. The proposed model initiate bandage products and managerial skill to handle the business activities as well as provoke, support and facilitate to other groups to identify and manage the similar livelihood activities.
